# Thames Water CMOS Tariff Codes 2018-19

Wholesale Tariff Document section numbers (e.g. B.4.1) relate to the 2018-19 Wholesale Tariff Document.

All of Thames Water's CMOS Tariff Codes start with NHH to indicate a non-household tariff.

This will be followed by a code indicating the Service Component type. If the Service Component code is prefixed with "SA" then this indicates a Special Agreement Tariff (B.4 Special agreement charges).

## **MPW & MS (WTD B.1)**

### **Volumetric Charges (WTD Table B.1-2)**

For Metered Water & Wastewater the Service Component code will be followed by a number identifying the tariff band.

### **MS Fixed Charges (WTD Table B.1-1)**

Metered customers are charged fixed charges for each meter based on the Sewerage Chargeable meter size. The letter following the Sewerage Band indicates whether the charges are from the column labelled Full or Abated.

When a large user tariff code is suffixed with “SAT” the supplementary large user charge is not applied to the SPID.

### **AW & AS (WTD B.2.4)**

#### **Volumetric Charges (WTD Table B.2-5)**

For assessed Water and Wastewater the Service Component code will be followed by a number identifying the tariff consumption band. This number should not be confused with the property band.

#### **AS Fixed Charges (WTD Table B.2-6)**

Assessed customers are charged fixed charges on each SPID’s Assessed Sewerage Chargeable meter size. The letter following the Sewerage Band indicates whether the charges are from the column labelled Full or Abated.

If an assessed customer has more than 1 pipe they will be charged a multiple of the standard fixed charges. In these cases the below code will be added to the end of the tariff code, where ## represents the number of pipes. Additionally these codes do not have a number representing tariff band and are charged the 0 – 20,000 rate.

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## UW & US (WTD B.2)

### Rateable Value Charges (WTD Table B.2-1)

For unmeasured Water and Wastewater charges, where the Service Component code is followed by a number, this represents the RV charging region based on the customer's Local Authority area.

### US Fixed Charges (WTD Table B.2-2)

Unmeasured customers are charged sewerage fixed charges on each SPID's Pipe Size. The letter following the Sewerage Band indicates whether the charges are from the column labelled Full Or Abated.

If an unmeasured customer has more than 1 pipe they will be charged a multiple of the standard fixed charges. In these cases the below code will be added to the end of the tariff code, where ## represents the number of pipes.

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### Drainage Only Charges (in WTD B.2 text)

Where the unmeasured Service Component code is followed by "DOF" this indicates the site only has surface water drainage and all accounts on this tariff code are charged a fixed annual charge.

### Sundry Charges (WTD Tables B.2-7, B.2-8, B.5-4)

Sundry Charges are applicable for all unmeasured accounts except drainage only properties. Charges only apply where the CMOS item count is >0. Where the unmeasured Service Component



code is followed by “SUN” this indicates that a SPID will only be charged sundry charges with no RV or pipe size element.
